Does every camper have to be proficient in order to join?

Our Rock Boot Camp is designed for the beginner/intermediate level rocker- students should have basic knowledge of his/her instrument which usually translates to a minimum of 6 months of experience

What is the cost?

Tuition is as follows:

\$550 *before* May 1st

\$600 *after* May 1st

Tuition is due in full by June 1st and is payable by cash or check only. A nonrefundable deposit of \$100 is required in order to save your slot. If the remaining balance is not received by June 1st, your space may be given to the next student on the waiting list

Refund Policy:

The deposit is non refundable. Before June 1st, you may request a refund for any other tuition funds that have been paid

Should students bring their own instruments?

Guitar and bass yes, but we provide amps, chords, drum sets, microphones and keyboards

Is lunch included?

Your rocker should bring a packed lunch everyday **except** for Wednesday, June 20th when we will go to a local restaurant for a fun lunch!
